# BIOSPHERE RESERVES

Biosphere Reserves are areas designated by UNESCO under the MAB (Man and the Biosphere) Programme with the intention of harmonising conservation of natural resources with human well-being.

They are appointed by the MAB International Coordinating Council at the request of the State concerned. Each Biosphere Reserve remains under the sovereign jurisdiction of the State in which it is located.

Collectively, they constitute a Global Network in which States participate voluntarily. The Network is governed by the Statutory Framework adopted by the UNESCO General Conference in 1995, which sets out the definition, objectives and criteria, as well as the designation procedure for Biosphere Reserves.

Biosphere Reserves are considered protected areas and fulfil the following functions:

- Contribute to the conservation of landscapes, ecosystems, species, and genetic variation.
- Promote socio-culturally and ecologically sustainable economic and human development.
- Support demonstration projects, environmental education and training, as well as the ongoing research and monitoring of local, regional, national and global conservation and sustainable development issues.

Castile and León has the following Reserves: Picos de Europa, Alto Bernesga, Meseta Ibérica, Los Ancares Leoneses, Babia, Los Argüellos, Sierra de Bejar y Francia, Valle de Laciana, Valles de Omana y Luna, Real Sitio de San Ildefonso - El Espinar.


# TOURIST PROPOSALS

## MONASTERIO MM. AGUSTINAS NUESTRA SEÑORA DE GRACIA AND ROYAL PALACE OF DON JUAN II, ÁVILA

In Madrigal de las Altas Torres we can visit the Monasterio MM. Agustinas Nuestra Señora de Gracia convent, former Royal Palace of Juan II and Birthplace of Isabella of Castile. It is also the starting point of the Isabella of Castile Route, which covers the main places of interest in the life of this queen. Isabella I of Castile was born on 22nd April 1451 in the former Royal Palace of Juan II, now occupied by the Monasterio de Nuestra Señora de Gracia. Also of note are the Ambassadors' Hall and its antechamber, the convent church and the royal bedroom of the palace where Isabella of Castile was born. The oldest part of the palace, known as the "Clastrillas", are rooms reserved for the use of the nuns of royal blood who took their vows in the convent. It was declared an Asset of Cultural Interest in 1942.

## VILLA ROMANA BAÑOS DE VALDEARADOS, RIBERA DEL DUERO, BURGOS

This magnificent Roman villa dates from the Lower Imperial period (4th and 5th centuries) and is located very close to the town of Clunia Sulpicia, near the Roman road that linked Zaragoza and Astorga. As was often the case, the site was discovered by chance, and excavations in the 1970s revealed a large villa typical of the Lower Roman Empire, was revealed. The excavated area of about 1000 m<sup>2</sup> shows only a part of the villa. Among the remains found there lies a rich collection of mosaics, the most important of which is the "Triumph of the God Bacchus" in the main hall of the Villa.



## RENAISSANCE ALTPARPIECES ROUTE OF EASTERN LEÓN

In some of the many churches located in the numerous villages of the province of León, we can find true marvels, authentic works of sacred art. Ten of them form the "Renaissance altarpieces route of eastern León". 76 kilometres link the towns of Vallecillo, Gordaliza del Pino, Sahagún, Joara, Celada de Cea, Valdescapa de Cea, Villaselán, Valdavida, Cistierna and Yugueros; the Route crosses the valleys of the rivers Esla, Cea and Valderaduey. This route through the ten villages also allows you to discover the local gastronomy and its different traditions.

## TOSANDE YEW FOREST TRAIL, PALENCIA

Yew is a naturally rare tree. In the Montaña Palentina, the yew is scattered and it is rare to find several specimens together. It is even more unusual to find specimens of the size and stature of the Tosande yews, some of which reach 1.5 metres in diameter. For this reason, the yew tree is considered a relic of the Tertiary Era, a true botanical jewel that deserves all the attention that will help to preserve it. October is a spectacular time to visit, when you can listen to the rutting of the stags and when autumn decorates the beech forest surrounding the yew with its many shades of leaves. A spectacle of smells and colours. The route starts in Dehesa de Montejo (near Cervera de Pisuerga) on the C-626 km.2. There is a car park where you can leave your car and start the approximately 11 km walk along a track and path. The difference in altitude is 500 metres and it usually lasts about three and a half hours.



## EMBROIDERY IN THE MOUNTAINS, SALAMANCA

One of the typical crafts of the Sierra de Francia is embroidery, which can be seen in scarves, bedspreads, tablecloths and so on, and is part of the identity of the villages of the Sierra de Francia. The technique, the motifs and the choice of colours have been handed down from generation to generation. Embroidery is usually done on linen or taffeta using primary-coloured threads. The most recurrent symbols are: A heart from which a flower blooms, representing love; the two-headed eagle, symbolising marriage; fertility, represented by the trout; the lion, symbolising man, an expression of virility, and the single-headed bird, representing woman; the tree of life, enveloping the whole, representing health and longevity. These wonders are displayed on the balconies on feast days or on altars on days such as Corpus Christi.

## JUDIÓN DE LA GRANJA, SEGOVIA

Segovian gastronomy is world-famous and one of its dishes is the Judión de La Granja. It has the appearance of a large, shiny white bean with a texture that is equally buttery and smooth. They can be prepared in different ways, according to the traditional recipe: with chorizo sausage, pig's ear or trotter, black pudding, onion, garlic, knuckle of ham, salt, oil, sweet paprika and bay leaf. Or with clams, with chard and chorizo, with oyster mushrooms, in salads... However you try them, they are sure to leave a great taste in your mouth.

## PLAZA DE HERRADORES, SORIA

This square, now called Ramón Benito Aceña but known for centuries as the Plaza de Herradores, is one of the most mythical squares in the city, a meeting place for all Soria's inhabitants and travellers. For all this and more, we can call it a legendary square, without forgetting that the Bécquer brothers also lived there, which also gives it a certain "literary flavour". It is also famous for the traditional flavours of its varied tapas and, of course, its torreznos, which can be tasted in various bars. In the past, the square was mainly used for commercial purposes. Today it boasts a bustling and lively atmosphere, always full of people, hosting concerts and various cultural and festive events. A must for those who want to immerse themselves in the most typical atmosphere of the city.

## DISCOVERING VALLADOLID BY BIKE

The province of Valladolid is ideal for cycling routes due to its orography. A healthy and environmentally friendly option in an area with few slopes. There are several routes in the urban area, including the Pisuerga route that passes by the Science Museum, the Millennium Dome, the Rosaleda Park, the Moreras beach and the Puente Mayor. The Canal de Castilla route starts in the La Victoria district of Valladolid and takes us to the Palencia region. Similarly, the Rueda wine route, to the south of Valladolid, is a 40-kilometre circular route that links the towns of Medina del Campo, La Seca, Rueda and Torrecilla del Valle. The best time of year is from April to the end of June, and from September to the end of October.

## ACEÑAS DE OLIVARES, ZAMORA

The Aceñas de Olivares are a group of mills located on the Duero riverbed. They have been out of use since the beginning of the 20th century, along with those of Pinilla, Cabañales, Gijón and Los Pisones. The term "aceñas" is reserved for those mechanisms that operate in high flow rivers, while the term "molinos" is reserved for those that operate in low flow rivers. The Aceñas de Olivares were the first industry in our city in the 10th century and reached their peak in the 18th century. They have been restored and consolidated to house the Interpretation Centre of Traditional Water Industries. In Zamora you can visit the water-powered mills displayed in the Aceñas de Olivares. You will see the hammer or mallet, with its forging work; the fulling mill, used to soften wool and flax, and the mill, used to grind grain to make flour. They can be visited free of charge, provided that the river flow and the weather allow them to be opened. You can take a trip along the Duero River in a rowing boat or cross from one bank to the other in a barge. These services are usually available during the summer season. Every year in August, very interesting dramatised nocturnal visits are organised in the Aceñas. For further information, please contact the tourist office.
